- Identified staff members with potential conflicts of interest: Jaycie and Karis (coaches/mentors at other sober living places), Taylor (ownership of sober living residences), and Rourke (owner of Red Point and coaching for another sober living).
- Discussed options for resolving ownership conflicts, including putting ownership on hold for Rourke and Taylor.
- Emphasized the need for transparency and fairness in addressing conflicts of interest so not one person feels discriminated against.

Conclusions: Jaycie and Karis' side jobs were deemed non-conflicting. Taylor and Rourke will be presented with three options: cease employment, continue with CARR while relinquishing ownership, or transfer ownership to a trust and continue employment.
