Dear Recovery Residence Operators,

I'm writing this to share some difficult news on behalf of the Colorado Association of Recovery Residences (CARR). After much reflection and with deep appreciation for the community we've built together, CARR will be closing its doors effective **June 30, 2025**. As of **effective immediately**, we will no longer be certifying recovery residences. For our members and community partners, Ohio Recovery Housing (ORH) has been designated as the next certifier for Colorado. Certified homes will be honored and carried over by the incoming organization, as well as minimal lapse from CARR to ORH for those organizations looking to become certified or renew.

This decision comes after a sustained period of financial hardship. Despite our best efforts to adapt and grow, the cost of maintaining high-quality services and meeting the increasing demands of our field has outpaced our available resources. We are proud of the work we've done and the standards we've upheld, but continuing operations is no longer financially sustainable.

We want to express our heartfelt gratitude to each of you. Your dedication to providing safe, supportive housing for individuals in recovery has been the foundation of everything we've accomplished. Your partnership has inspired us and strengthened the recovery community across Colorado.

As we wind down operations, we are working closely with the **Behavioral Health Administration (BHA)** to ensure a smooth and thoughtful transition for all providers. Our shared goal is to minimize disruption and support continuity for the individuals and communities you serve.

Please note that CARR will be reducing its workforce in the coming weeks to manage expenses, and response times may be delayed.
